

Finding DVDs/Videos – Daytona Beach Campus

There are three different sources for the DVDs and videos that are available through the Hunt Library.



- A. ONLINE CATALOG** – lists DVDs/Videos available from the Hunt Library
- B. FILMS ON DEMAND** – provides access to web-based video titles from the Films Media Group
- C. STREAMING VIDEOS ON THE WEB** – provides access to a variety of selected videos

A. ONLINE CATALOG

- Start at the **Hunt Library home page** (<http://library.erau.edu>) and choose your affiliation: **Daytona Beach Campus**
- Click on **Find DVDs/Videos**
- Click on **Enter the Online Catalog**
- Click on **Basic Search**

Important Information to Know When Searching for DVDs/Videos

Basic Search Screen

- Use the **Basic Search** screen for topic or keyword searches.
- You must type the word *video?* into one of the **Search for:** boxes (the ? is the truncation symbol which allows Voyager to search for variant word endings such as *videotape*, *videorecording*, etc. *Video?* will even help you locate DVDs).
- Always select the **all of these** option for searching.
- In the **Search by:** box always select **Keyword Anywhere**.

Searching by Topic or Keyword

To find videos on a certain topic, such as safety, do the following:

- Enter the keyword *safety* in the first **Search for:** box.
- Enter the keyword *video?* in the second **Search for:** box.
- Click on the **Search** button.

Full View

Displays the complete item record for the selected title. This screen will include the subject heading(s), publisher, copyright date, and number of copies. The item record also provides the length of the program, the call number of the item(s), and a brief description of the program itself. It will also tell you when a checked out item is due.

Requesting Videos/DVDs for Preview

Staff and Faculty may request videos or DVDs to preview for classroom use. These materials may be borrowed for three days. If the materials are needed for a longer period, please notify Media Services Staff and additional time will be given if possible.

Videos/DVDs may be requested in several ways:

- Start at <http://library.erau.edu> then choose **Daytona Beach Campus** > click **Find DVDs/Videos** > click **Media Equipment/Video Request Form**
- Call 386-226-6605 and make your request by telephone
- Send an email to media@erau.edu with your request

Please include your name, telephone number or extension, the title(s) and call numbers of the videos or DVDs you are requesting, the classroom or office where they should be delivered, and the date and time they are needed. Materials may also be picked up at the Media Services Department in the library.

Students

Students may check out videos or DVDs with their valid Eagle Card for use in the library. Students may view videos or DVDs in the preview area just outside the Media Services Department. Materials are checked out for two-hour periods and may be renewed up to three times.

If a student needs a video or DVD for a classroom presentation, they must ask their professor to request the material on their behalf for the date and time needed.

Making Purchase Requests for Videos or DVDs

Staff, faculty, and students are welcome to submit recommendations of video or DVD titles for purchase. The Library's Collection Development Committee considers these recommendations and makes all purchasing decisions. To submit a purchase request, start at <http://library.erau.edu> then choose **Daytona Beach Campus** > click **Recommend New Materials** > click **Recommend Media (DVD/Video)** and fill out the form completely.

B. FILMS ON DEMAND

- Go to the **Hunt Library home page** (<http://library.erau.edu>).
- Click on **Daytona Beach Campus**.
- Click on **Find Articles (Databases)**.
- After reading the instructions, click on **ERNIE** (<http://ernie.erau.edu>).
- Login to **ERNIE** with your username and password.
- Scroll down to find the **Admin Services** module. (If you don't see this module, click on your browser's refresh or reload icon and it will usually appear.)
- Click on **Library Databases** which will take you to the **Databases** access page. (You will remain signed into this page until you close your browser. This feature allows you to search additional web databases without signing in again.)
- Locate **Films On Demand** from the alphabetical list and click on **Films On Demand**.

IMPORTANT: If **Films On Demand** requires another Username and Password for log in, you may need to temporarily disable any firewall installed on your computer. Firewalls often interfere with the log in process.

Conduct a Search

- Enter your search term(s) in the box next to **Embry-Riddle**.
- **Search Tips**
 - Use **and** between words to ensure that each term is present somewhere in the search results: *labor and airlines*.
- Click on the red arrow or hit the **Enter** key to start your search.

Browse Collection

Under the **All Videos** tab you can browse the Hunt Library's collection of **Films On Demand** titles one of two ways - alphabetically or by subject.

- To browse the collection alphabetically, enter a page number in the **Go to page** box and then click on the red arrow located at both the top and bottom of the title list.
- To browse the collection by subject, choose one of the **Subject Folders** to see a list of titles.

View Titles

- Click on the **Play Video** button or on the title you want to view, then click on the play button in either **Windows Media Player** or **QuickTime Player**.
- By default, titles are to play in their entirety but can also be played by segment.

Note: In order to use **Films On Demand** you will need a current version of **Windows Media Player** or **QuickTime Player**. These players can be downloaded for free. Simply click on the links below and follow the instructions to install the product.

Windows Media Player – links for MAC and PCs

Start at <http://microsoft.com> > click Downloads and Trials from right-hand menu > click Windows Media Player Downloads in center of screen > choose the appropriate Windows Media player.

QuickTime – links for MAC and PCs

Start at <http://www.apple.com> > click Downloads from top menu > click QuickTime from center of screen > download appropriate player.

Important: **Films On Demand** can only be viewed using Internet Explorer, and is not currently supported by any other web browser.

C. STREAMING VIDEOS ON THE WEB

The Hunt Library has chosen a variety of streaming videos found freely on the web and have made them available on the Hunt Library website.

- Go to the **Hunt Library home page** (<http://library.erau.edu>).
- Click on **Daytona Beach Campus**.
- Click on **Find DVDs/Videos**.
- Under Online Video, click on **Streaming Video on the Web**.
