



Using Aviation Week Intelligence Network (AWIN)

Daytona Beach Campus Online Instructions

IMPORTANT: PRINT THESE INSTRUCTIONS NOW FOR USE WHILE SEARCHING.

Aviation Week Intelligence Network (AWIN) provides complete (full-text) articles from publications covering aviation/aerospace, airports, air traffic control, safety and maintenance, homeland security, and business. Coverage: 1997-current (varies per newsletter). AWIN also offers searchable access to the **World Aerospace Database (WAD)** organization profiles and **Fleet** profiles.

A. Access AWIN

- ◆ Go to the **Hunt Library home page** (<http://library.erau.edu>).
- ◆ Click on **Daytona Beach Campus**.
- ◆ Click on **Find Articles (Databases)**.
- ◆ Click on **Using the Databases**.
- ◆ After reading the instructions, click on the **ERNIE** (<http://ernie.erau.edu>) link.
- ◆ Login to **ERNIE** with your username and password.
- ◆ Scroll down to find the **Admin Services** module. (If you don't see this module, click on your browser's refresh or reload icon and it will usually appear.)
- ◆ Click on **Library Databases** which will take you to the **Databases** access page. You will remain signed into this page until you close your browser. This feature allows you to search additional web databases without signing in again.
- ◆ Locate **Aviation Week Intelligence Network** from the alphabetical list and click on **Aviation Week Intelligence Network**.

IMPORTANT: If this database requires another Username and Password for login, you may need to temporarily disable any firewall installed on your computer. Firewalls often interfere with the login process.

B. View the Current Issue of a Publication

- ◆ From the **Publications** menu to the left of the page, click on the title of the publication you would like to view. (The check mark denotes publications that are included in the Library's subscription.) The most recent issue will automatically be displayed in its entirety.

C. Search AWIN

- ◆ Articles can be located in the AWIN publications using either the **Quick Search** or **Advanced Search** options, as follows:
 - **Quick Search:**
 - To search for articles across all publications simultaneously, enter your search terms in the **AWIN Quick Search** text box in the upper left corner of the AWIN homepage. (If you are not currently on the AWIN homepage, click **Home** in the upper left corner of the screen.) You may need to experiment with different terms or combinations of terms to find exactly what you are seeking.
 - Click on the **FIND NOW** button.
 - To view the full text of an article, click on its title.
 - **Advanced Search:**
 - To search a different combination of publications or refine your search in other ways, click the **GO** icon next to **Articles** in the **AWIN Advanced Searches** options in the upper right corner of the screen.
 - For articles, use the **Natural Language** or **Boolean Search** options in Step 1 to enter terms.
 - In Step 2, apply the desired filters, then click the **APPLY FILTERS** icon in Step 3 to run the search.
 - After the search is complete, a box titled **4. View Results** will appear to the right. Click the **View Results** icon to display article titles and brief descriptions.
 - Click on the desired article title to display the full text and print options.

D. Find Information Using the Channels

- ◆ The **Channels** are instant search options which will automatically retrieve articles and other data on specific topics from all subscribed publications in the AWIN database. To access a Channel, click on any of the following terms near the top of the screen on the AWIN home page:
 - **Commercial Aviation**
 - **Defense**
 - **MRO** (Maintenance/Repair/Overhaul)
 - **Space**
 - **Business Aviation**
 - **Charts & Graphs**

E. Print Articles

- ◆ To print an article from a newsletter:
 - Some articles offer **PDF (Adobe Reader)** versions; if so, an icon labeled **Download PDF version** will appear. Just click this icon and then use the Reader's print button. (To download the free Reader or update to the latest version, visit [Adobe's website](#).)
 - Other articles offer only **HTML** versions; if so, an icon labeled either **Print This Page** or **Print This Article** should appear above the article title. Clicking this icon should open a new window with a plain-text version of the article.
 - Click on the **Print This Page** icon that appears again above the article title in the new window.

F. Locate World Aerospace Database (WAD) Organization Profiles

- ◆ From the AWIN home page, click the **GO** icon next to **World Aerospace Database** in the upper right corner of the screen.
- ◆ In Step 1, select report type and formatting.
- ◆ In Step 2, click on the + signs to the left of each filter category to expand the options.
- ◆ Enter the desired company name and select the desired criteria from the options below. You may need to experiment with different combinations of criteria and/or keywords to find what you are seeking.
- ◆ After all desired criteria have been selected, click the **Apply Filters** button that appears at the bottom of each filter category. A search results box will appear on the right. Click the **View Results** icon to display profiles.
- ◆ Click on the desired profile to display full text, print, and export options.

G. Locate Fleet Profiles

- ◆ From the AWIN home page, click the **GO** icon next to **Fleet** in the upper right corner of the screen.
- ◆ Expand the categories to enter keywords and select filter criteria. You may need to experiment with different combinations of criteria and/or keywords to find what you are seeking.
- ◆ After all desired criteria are selected, click on the **Apply Filters** button that appears at the bottom of each filter category. The search results listing the profile(s) that fit your criteria will appear.
- ◆ Click on the desired profile to display full text, print, and export options.

Important: AWIN provides online help for use while searching. To access the online help, click on **User Guide** in the **Useful Links** section on the right side of the AWIN home page. **PowerPoint** or a similar type of presentation software is required to view the **User Guide**.
