

Using ACM Digital Library (Association for Computing Machinery)

Embry-Riddle Worldwide Online Instructions



IMPORTANT: PRINT THESE INSTRUCTIONS NOW FOR USE WHILE SEARCHING.

ACM Digital Library provides complete (full-text) access to all ACM journals, magazines, proceedings, and transactions published by the Association for Computing Machinery. Coverage: 1950-current (varies). *This database allows three concurrent users. If you cannot connect, please try again at a later time.*

The following instructions will tell you how to:

- A. Access ACM Digital Library
- B. Conduct a Search
- C. Browse ACM Digital Library
- D. Print or Download Complete (Full-Text) Articles

A. Access ACM Digital Library

- ◆ Go to the **Hunt Library home page** (<http://library.erau.edu>).
- ◆ Click on **Embry-Riddle Worldwide**.
- ◆ Click on **Find Articles (Databases)**.
- ◆ Click on **Using the Databases**.
- ◆ After reading the instructions, click on the **ERNIE** (<http://ernie.erau.edu>) link.
- ◆ Login to **ERNIE** with your username and password.
- ◆ Scroll down to find the **Admin Services** module. (If you don't see this module, click on your browser's refresh or reload icon and it will usually appear.)
- ◆ Click on **Library Databases** which will take you to the **Databases** access page. You will remain signed into this page until you close your browser. This feature allows you to search additional web databases without signing in again.
- ◆ Locate **ACM Digital Library** from the alphabetical list and click on **ACM Digital Library**.

IMPORTANT: If this database requires another Username and Password for login, you may need to temporarily disable any firewall installed on your computer. Firewalls often interfere with the login process.

B. Conduct a Search

- ◆ Enter your search term(s) in the **Search** box.
- ◆ **Search Tips**
 - Use double quotation marks around a phrase: *"human factors."* Use **and** between words to ensure that each term is present somewhere in the search results: *"human factors" and "keyboard design."* For other search tips, click on the **Search Tips** link on the **Results** screen.

- ◆ Click on **Search**.
- ◆ From the Search Results list, click on the document title to see bibliographic information and an abstract, or the **PDF** icon to view the full-text document.

C. Browse ACM Digital Library

- ◆ Under **Browse the Digital Library**, click on the type of publication you want, which could include journals, magazines, etc.
- ◆ Click on the specific title you want. For many of these, you may browse the **Current Issue** or back issues (**Archive**), or you may search within a particular publication.

D. Print or Download Complete (Full-Text) Articles

- ◆ Each page of the results list will show up to twenty (20) records. If more than twenty entries were retrieved, use **Previous** and **Next** at the top or bottom of the list to move between pages.
- ◆ Use either the print function within the Adobe Reader or your browser's print function to print the article.
- ◆ Or, you may download the article using the Adobe Reader's save function.

Note: You should have full-text access to **ALL** Journals, Magazines, Proceedings, Transactions, and to **SOME** of the other types of publications.

Important: **ACM Digital Library** provides online help for use while searching the database. To access the online help, click on the **Search Tips** tab at the top of the results screen after you have performed your search.
